



2020 Christmas Cash Lottery Rules and Regulations for Licence #563275

- Lottery tickets shall not be sold to a person under the age of 18 years. Adult ticket buyers are advised not to write the name of a person under the age of 18 years on the ticket stub.
- Alberta SPCA Board members, and/or members of their immediate family (spouse, parents, children or siblings) that reside in the same household, are not eligible to purchase tickets. Alberta SPCA employees, and/or members of their immediate family (spouse, parents, children or siblings) that reside in the same household, are not eligible to purchase tickets.
- Discounted prices (\$20 per ticket for 3 or more tickets) apply only when tickets are purchased at the same time. Otherwise, the cost of \$25 per ticket shall apply. Number of tickets equals 4,000 tickets at \$25 each and 16,500 tickets at \$20 each.
- All draws will be made at the Alberta SPCA head office at 17904 118 Ave NW, Edmonton, AB T5S 2W3 by a person who does not have a ticket or interest in the draw.
- Ticket orders must be received by 4:30 p.m. on Nov 24, 2020 for guaranteed eligibility for the early bird draws on Dec 4, 2020. Ticket orders must be received by 4:30 p.m. on Dec 8, 2020 for guaranteed eligibility for the final draws on Dec 18, 2020.
- If all tickets are sold on or prior to Nov 24, 2020 all draws will be made on Dec 4, 2020 with AGLC approval. If all tickets are not sold by Nov 24, 2020 the final draw for all remaining prizes will be held on Dec 18, 2020. The Early Bird prizes will be drawn in the following order: 2 prizes of \$10,000 each. The final prizes will be drawn in the following order: 25 prizes of \$1,000 each, 5 prizes of \$2,000 each, 2 prizes of \$5,000 each, 1 grand prize of \$25,000.
- Winning ticket stubs will be returned to the drum after each draw to be eligible for additional prizes.
- Winners will be contacted by telephone and/or email within 7 days of the draw and by mail if they cannot be contacted by telephone or email. The prize winner has one year from the draw date to collect their prize.
- If a winner has been notified by telephone and/or email and/or registered mail and the prize is not claimed within one year, the Alberta SPCA will contact the AGLC for permission to award the prize to the Alberta SPCA.
- Tickets may be purchased and sold in Alberta only.
- Prizes are presented in the form of a cheque in the name of the ticket winner. Prizes will be either mailed to the winner, or they can be picked up by the winner at 17904 118 Ave Edmonton AB during the hours of 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday. In the event a winning ticket stub has more than one name on it, the prize will be awarded to only one of the individuals identified on the ticket. The Alberta SPCA and the AGLC are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.
- No ticket refunds will be given after the first draw is made. Ticket stubs must accompany all refunded tickets. Ticket refunds may take up to four weeks to process, and refunds will be issued in the form of a cheque.
- A minimum of 11,000 tickets must be sold by Nov 24, 2020. If 11,000 tickets are not sold by this date the Alberta SPCA reserves the right to contact the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission and ask for both sales and draw date extensions.
- All draws are video taped, and members of the public may view the tape or attend the draws. All costs incurred with participating in these activities are the responsibility of the individual, not the Alberta SPCA.
- No postdated cheques please.
