



2021 Christmas 50/50 Raffle Rules and Regulations for Licence #576489

- Lottery tickets shall not be sold to a person under the age of 18 years. Adult ticket buyers are advised not to write the name of a person under the age of 18 years on the ticket stub.
- Alberta SPCA Board members, and/or members of their immediate family (spouse, parents, children or siblings) that reside in the same household, are not eligible to purchase tickets. Alberta SPCA employees, and/or members of their immediate family (spouse, parents, children or siblings) that reside in the same household, are not eligible to purchase tickets.
- Tickets may be purchased and sold in Alberta only.
- Total ticket value is \$100,000. Tickets are available as follows:
 - Series A: 125 tickets for \$10 each
 - Series B: 1,250 sets of 3 tickets for \$20
 - Series C: 475 sets of 8 tickets for \$50
 - Series D: 500 sets of 20 tickets for \$100The total number of tickets is 17,675.
- All ticket numbers will be emailed to purchasers by the registered Electronic Raffle Supplier (ERS) whenever possible. Ticket numbers will only be mailed to purchasers who do not provide a valid email address.
- Draw will be made at the Alberta SPCA head office at 17904 118 Ave NW, Edmonton, AB T5S 2W3 by a person who does not have a ticket or interest in the draw. Winner will be determined by a random draw utilizing an Alberta Gaming Liquor and Cannabis (AGLC) registered ERS Random Number Generator (RNG).
- All draws are recorded and witnessed by (at minimum) two elected executives of the Alberta SPCA and one member of the public. Members of the public may view the recording or attend the draws. All costs incurred with participating in these activities are the responsibility of the individual, not the Alberta SPCA.
- Ticket orders must be received by 11:59 p.m. on Dec 7, 2021 for guaranteed eligibility for the draw on Dec 17, 2021.
- Winners will be contacted by telephone and/or email within 7 days of the draw and by mail if they cannot be contacted by telephone or email. The prize winner has one year from the draw date to collect their prize.
- If a winner has been notified by telephone and/or email and/or registered mail and the prize is not claimed within one year, the Alberta SPCA will contact the AGLC for permission to award the prize to the Alberta SPCA.
- The raffle prize is cash; prize winner takes 50% of total ticket sales to maximum of \$50,000. Prize is presented in the form of a cheque in the name of the ticket winner. Prizes will be either mailed to the winner, or they can be picked up by the winner at 17904 118 Ave Edmonton AB during the hours of 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday.
- In the event a winning ticket has more than one name on it, the prize will be awarded to only one of the individuals identified on the ticket. The Alberta SPCA and the AGLC are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket.
- No ticket refunds will be given after the first draw is made. Ticket refunds may take up to four weeks to process, and refunds will be issued in the form of a cheque.
- A minimum of 8,900 tickets must be sold by Nov 23, 2021. If 8,900 tickets are not sold by this date the Alberta SPCA reserves the right to contact the AGLC and ask for both sales and draw date extensions.
- By purchasing tickets, winners consent to having their name, winning numbers published.
